#### a) Adjectives

- 1. Adjektive beschreiben Eigenschaften von **Nomen**. Sie drücken also aus, wie eine Sache oder eine Person ist.
  - → adjective + noun: a happy girl/a small shirt.
- 2. In Verbindung mit den Formen von "to be" wird das Adjektiv verwendet.
  - → "to be" + adjective: She is happy./The shirt is small.
- 3. Die Verben der Sinneswahrnehmung werden mit dem Adjektiv verwendet.
  - → feel, look, smell, sound, taste + adjective: That looks great./I feel fine.

#### b) Adverbs

Adverbien beschreiben Verben (Tätigkeiten) näher (vgl. Ad**verb – Verb**). Sie drücken also aus, wie etwas getan wird oder passiert.

→ verb + adverb: She reads quickly./He sings badly.

Regelmäßige Bildung der Adverbien: Adjektiv + Endung -ly
