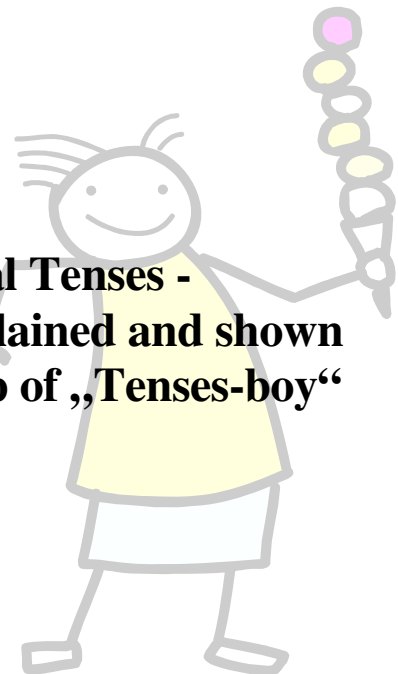

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## Preface

The figure of the "Tenses-boy" revealed as a useful device for teaching grammatical tenses, especially to children in 4<sup>th</sup> grade elementary school, but also for more advanced students.

The student can also regard him as a didactical help.

Head and body as the middle of the "Tenses-boy" always refer to the Present Tense, the left arm points to the Past Tense and the right arm points to the Future Tense. The bent-joints show the sequence of tenses.

Good progress was made especially when the students were taught privately by a tutor.

This booklet and the "Tenses-boy" are a short help to teach tenses. Rare specialties concerning grammar cannot be found here.
