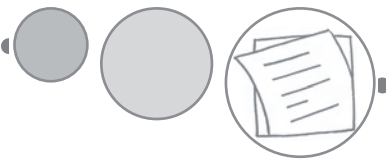
## Wie bereite ich mich vor?

## 2.5 Reacting to Prompts



### 1 At school

Sue and Rachel are in their classroom and Sue has got some problems to find her school things. If you have a partner, you can change the roles.

<i>Rolle A: Sue</i>	<i>Rolle B: Rachel</i>
– see my pencil case? – workbook – disappear (= verschwinden), too. – help – search – ? – need – next lesson.  When – English test. Jamie – what – with my pencil case and workbook? – not – grin so cheekily. Give – immediately.	No – Really? Where – ? Of course. – think ... Where – be? When – see it last?  Look – the boy's table. Jamie does have it!

### 2 A phone call with the tourist office

You are on the phone with a tourist office because you want to travel to Scotland. The officer gives you the information you need. If you have a partner, you can change the roles.

<i>Rolle A: You</i>	<i>Rolle B: Officer</i>
Hello. – 'd like to – which offers you have – this summer. – family and I want – to Scotland. Well, – need – hotel – Edinburgh.  – think – stay one week.  How much – for one week? – two adults – two children. – think – good offer. Can – book – ?  Sure. – from 17 <sup>th</sup> to 24 <sup>th</sup> August.  Very good. Thank – goodbye.	Good afternoon. Where exactly – want – travel?  Oh, – very nice city. How many nights – want to book? Let's see ... – some great hotels – city centre. – think – best offer – from the "Apollo Hotel". Well, – how many persons? That's £533.17. Of course! – will inscribe (= eintragen) you. – you tell – the calendar date – your journey? All right. – print – confirmation letter (= Bestätigungsschreiben). – welcome. Goodbye.

### 3 What's your favourite film?

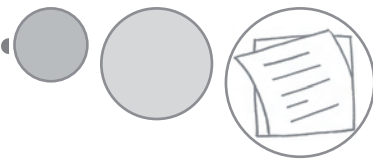
Katie and Hazel are talking about their favourite films. If you have a partner, you can change the roles.

<i>Rolle A: Katie</i>	<i>Rolle B: Hazel</i>
– favourite film? – fantastic! – like – too. – “Pirates of the Caribbean” – Johnny Depp – good-looking. – played – “Twilight”, didn’t he? – big fan – . – good idea. What – watch? – when – meet? See – next weekend. – looking forward – .	– “Lord of the Rings” – yours? – like – but Robert Pattinson – favourite actor. Hey, – go – cinema – next weekend. – like – see – new action film – Jackie Chan. – 6 o’clock – café. So – I. See you. Bye.

### 4 “I fell in love.”

John needs some help to invite a girl. He’s talking to his friend Marc. If you have a partner, you can change the roles.

<i>Rolle A: John</i>	<i>Rolle B: Marc</i>
Marc, – problem – your help. – fell in love – girl next door. – don’t know – likes me. – too shy – afraid that – say “no”. Really? – say anything? – ask her – go to a restaurant – buy her – best pizza.	Okay, John. What – problem? (laughing) – she – nice girl. What – problem? Ask – go out with you. Why –? – sure she – happy. – saw how she looked at you – Friday. No, but – know – likes pizza – saw her eat – . Good strategy. – think – try it with pretty Lisa, too.



### 5 Plans for the weekend

Louis and Nelson are making plans for their weekend. If you have a partner, you can change the roles.

<i>Rolle A: Louis</i>	<i>Rolle B: Nelson</i>
– plans – next weekend?	– thought – biking tour – mountains. – are you planning – ?
– haven't got any plans – alone – Saturday.	Well, – come with me?
– great idea! But first – repair – bike.	No problem. We – do this – Friday.
– equipment – we need?	– tent (= Zelt), good shoes, ...
– not forget – need – food.	Oh, Louis, – really greedy (= gefräßig).

### 6 A very normal afternoon

Elias is in a hurry and is searching for some things in the house. He asks his wife Sarah where they could be. If you have a partner, you can change the roles.

<i>Rolle A: Elias (husband)</i>	<i>Rolle B: Sarah (wife)</i>
Sarah, – see my blue t-shirt – white stripes?	– where – always is. Look – it by yourself.
Oh, come on, – searched – everywhere, – not find – .	No wonder! – because – disorder – your wardrobe.
Sorry, darling!	Here it is. – already walked the dog today?
No, – not find – leash (= Hundeleine).	Elias! – not be true. – put it onto – usual shelf yesterday.
– but – not there.	– must have put it away after – last walk.
Oh, – remember. – in – car.	– shouldn't – there. – you already – shopping for – dinner tomorrow?
Oh, right, – neighbours – come for dinner tomorrow.	– not tell me – forgot about it.
Er, ...	Oh, Elias, come on! Go – right now.
Okay, okay ... And darling, do never forget – you – my true love.
