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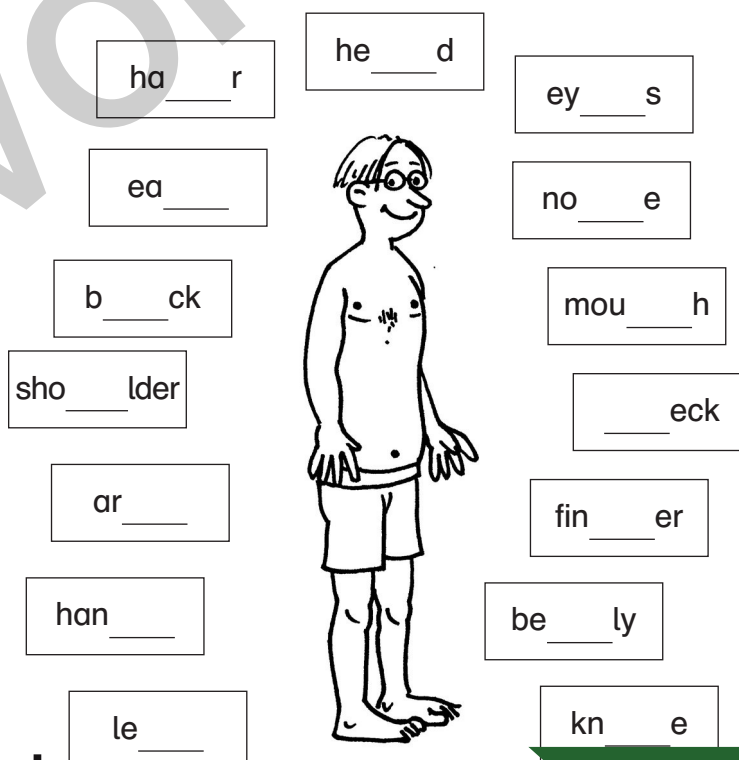

“Woof!”

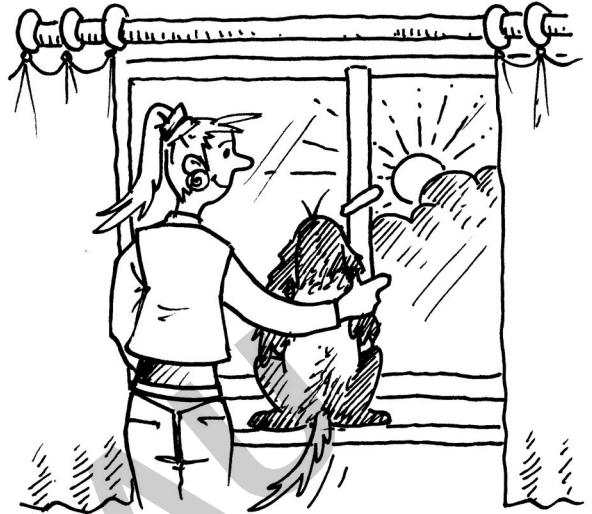
“But it’s cold and windy.

“There is a blue car.”

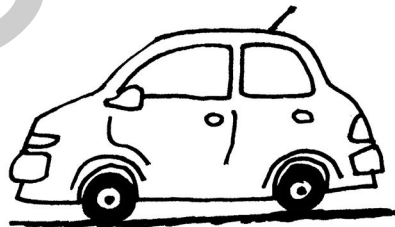
“Rrrrrrr!”

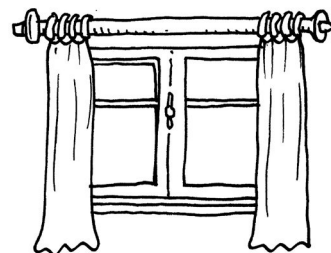

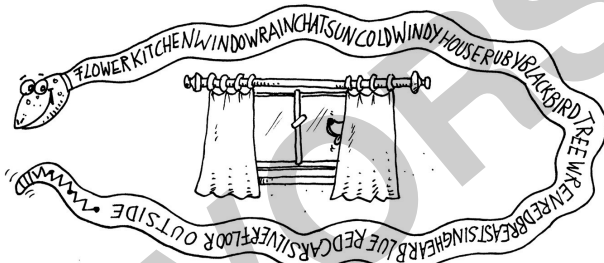

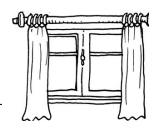
