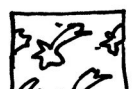
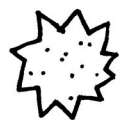

No, it isn't.

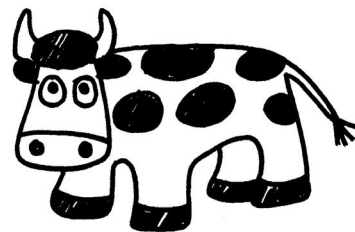


Is the cow behind the curtain?

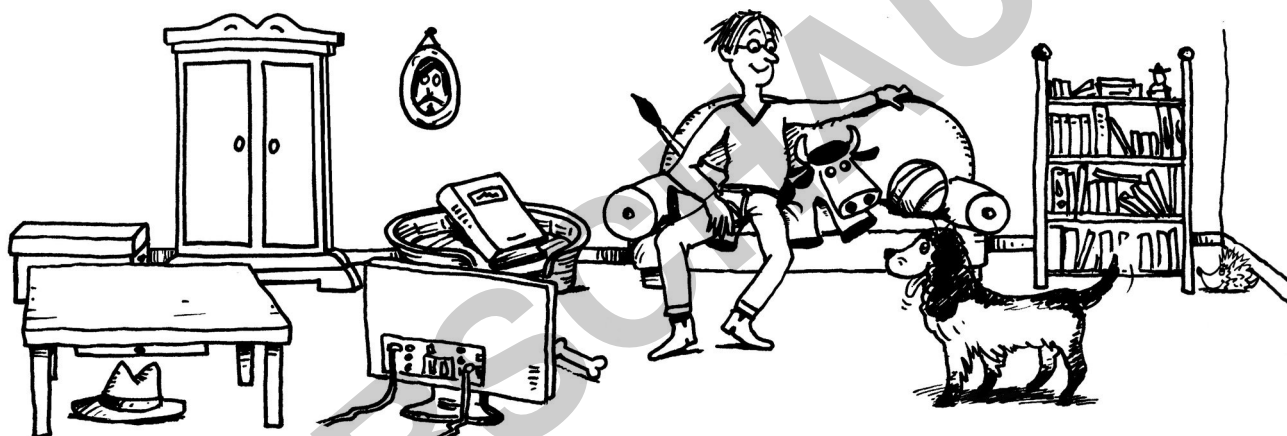
