Bildung der Present Tense Progressive Form:

Verbform in der Grundform + Nachsilbe -ing z.B. to sing + -ing = singing

## Beachte:

a) Stummes -e am Wortende fällt weg:

to take -e+ing = taking to have -e+ing = having to come -e+ing = coming

b) Verdoppelung der Endkonsonanten nach kurz gesprochenen Vokalen:

to stop +p+ing = stopping to run +n+ing = running to get +t+ing = getting


