

Two months before they wanted to marry, one of the worst disasters in the history of the USA destroyed their dreams: the terrorist attacks on the World Trade Center on September 11, 2001.

Task

At the moment, Joseph is in Stuttgart to visit his brother. Ask questions, please.

- *Frage ihn, wie er sich fühlt, fünfzehn Jahre nach dem schrecklichen Angriff auf das World Trade Center.*

Joseph: Well, I can't forget that day, never in my life. And I can't forget Emily, her beautiful eyes and her bright smile.

- *Frage ihn, ob er seitdem ein anderes Mädchen geheiratet hat.*

Joseph: No, I haven't. She was my "shining star". It would have been wrong to marry another girl.

- *Bitte ihn, dir etwas von dem Mädchen zu erzählen, das sein Herz berührte.*

Joseph: Emily was one of nearly 3,000 victims of the terrorist attacks on the WTC on September 11, 2001. She worked for a banking firm as a financial analyst. Her office was on the 81st floor of the South Tower of the World Trade Center in New York City.

- *Frage Joseph, wo sie herkam.*

Joseph: Emily was born in 1975 and grew up in Albany, the capital of the state of New York. She graduated from high school top in her class of 341 students. She was a class officer and involved in many school activities such as cheerleading and "Teen of the Year". She was also active as a hospital volunteer.

- *Frage, was sie nach der Schule machte.*

Joseph: I know that she graduated with a Bachelor of Science Degree in Business Administration and then did voluntary training in different firms. One day, her dream came true: She had always wanted to live in the Big Apple and be successful there.

- *Frage, wie und wann ihr euch kennengelernt habt.*

Joseph: I met her at a musical on Broadway. We were sitting next to each other and got in contact. Well, she liked musicals very much.

- *Du möchtest auch wissen, ob er sich erinnern kann, welches Musical es damals war.*

Joseph: Naturally, it was "The Lion King".

- *Erkundige dich, ob Emilys Eltern noch leben und ob sie Geschwister hat.*

Joseph: Well, she has one brother, who misses her very much. He loved her dearly. Her mother survived Emily for only three months. One day she decided to end her life. She jumped from the top of a skyscraper. It was terrible.
