

1.1 Present Tense Simple

1.1.1 Mit by-agent



Nearly everyone plays football. Football is played by nearly everyone.

Beide Sätze haben ungefähr die gleiche Bedeutung:

Nearly everyone plays football. Fast jeder spielt Fußball.

► Active Voice.

Football is played by nearly everyone. Fußball wird von fast jedem gespielt.

Passive Voice.

Im ersten Satz stehen die handelnden Personen im Mittelpunkt:

Nearly everyone

plays football.

Im zweiten Satz steht das, was gemacht wird, im Mittelpunkt:

Football

Passive Voice benutzen wir, wenn unser Interesse nicht den handelnden Personen oder Gegenständen gilt, sondern den Vorgängen.

George	IS	LIKED	BY EVERYONE.	
Tests	ARE	HATED	BY MOST PUPILS.	
I	AM	DRIVEN to school	BY MY FATHER.	








