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snowy		The adjective for snow.	The weather must be like this when you want to build a snowman or start a snowball fight.
hot		It's a word to describe very warm temperatures. It's the opposite of 'cold'.	When your ice cream melts (= <i>schmelzen</i> ) while you eat it, it's ... outside.
cold		In winter you have to wear warm clothes because it's ... outside.	The opposite of 'hot'.
degrees		Today it's sunny. It's 25 ...	In a lot of recipes (= <i>Rezepte</i> ) it says: "Set the oven to 175 ... Celsius." In an American recipe it would say: "Set the oven to 350 ... Fahrenheit."

3 Use the word on your card to write a few sentences about what makes you feel like that and why.

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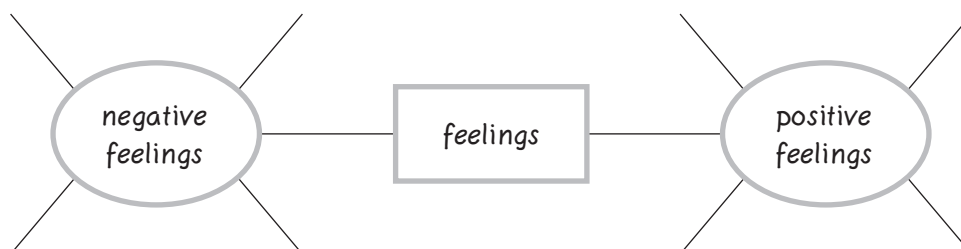


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4 Draw up a mind map about feelings. Think of positive and negative feelings. Try to draw a smiley which goes with every adjective to explain the word.

1 Copy the cards that you and your three partners have got.

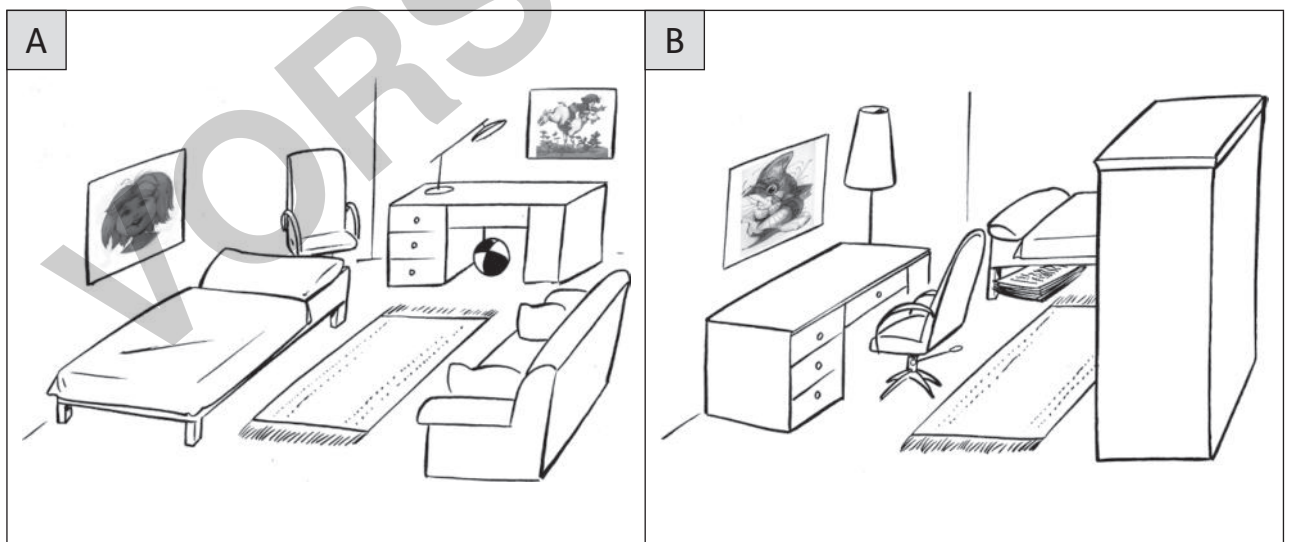
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2 It was...
