upstairs		A house has two levels (= Ebenen). You usually describe them as and downstairs.	The floor (= Stockwerk) in a building that is above the ground floor (= Erdgeschoss).
downstairs		The opposite of 'upstairs'.	The lower floor (= Stockwerk) of a house, especially the one at ground level (= ebenerdig).
balcony		It's a thing attached to (= angeschlossen an) the house which makes it possible to go outside even if you live upstairs.	A platform that is built on the upstairs outside wall of a building, with a wall or rail (= Geländer) around it.
hall		This room is usually the first one you enter when you go into a house or flat. You take off your coat and shoes there.	A passage inside the entrance (= Eingang) of a building. It can have rooms on either side (= auf beiden Seiten).


