Wann wird some verwendet?	Wann wird any verwendet?
<p>→ Wenn man einen positiven Aussagesatz bildet. <i>I have some water with me.</i></p>	<p>→ Wenn man einen negativen Aussagesatz bildet. <i>I don't want any water.</i></p>
<p>→ Wenn man eine Frage stellt und als Antwort ein „Ja“ erwartet. <i>Can I have some tea, please?</i> <i>May I open some windows, please?</i></p>	<p>→ Wenn man eine allgemeine Frage stellt. <i>Are there any more biscuits in the bag?</i></p>

Object pronouns (Objektpronomen) können das Objekt eines Satzes ersetzen.

→ Das Objekt ist eine **Ergänzung des Satzes** und steht meist an **letzter Stelle**.

Die *object pronouns* sind:

me	mir/mich	„Can you help me , please?“
you	dir/dich; Ihnen/Sie	I can help you !
him	ihm/ihn	You can play with Greg . – You can play with him .
her	ihr/sie	You must ask Carrie . – You must ask her .
it	ihm/ihn; ihr/sie; es	I love my dog . – I love it .
us	uns	You can play with my friends and me . – You can play with us .
you	euch; Ihnen/Sie	Can I play with you and your brother ? – Can I play with you ?“
them	ihnen/sie	I help my brother and his friends . – I help them .
