


EXPLANATION: SKIMMING

READING

Das **Skimming** ist eine **Lesestrategie**, welche man meistens anwendet, wenn man an einem neuen Text arbeitet.

- Skimming wird auch als **orientierendes Lesen** bezeichnet.
- Beim Skimming **überfliegt** man den Text, um sich einen **groben Überblick** zu verschaffen.



Folgende Informationen kann man mithilfe von Skimming einem Text entnehmen:

1. Um welche **Textart** handelt es sich?
Z. B. Brief, Postkarte, Geschichte, Informationstext, ...
2. Welche **Charaktere** werden in dem Text angesprochen?
Z. B. um wen geht es in der Geschichte, für wen ist der Brief, ...
3. Welche **Handlung** oder **Schlüsselinformationen** kannst du dem Text entnehmen?
Gibt es **Schlüsselwörter**, die auf den Inhalt hinweisen?

EXPLANATION: SCANNING


READING

Das **Scanning** ist eine **Lesestrategie**, welche man meistens anwendet, wenn man nach **bestimmten Informationen** in einem Text sucht. Wie ein Scanner **überfliegt** man den Text mit seinen Augen.

- Beim Scanning sieht man sich den Text nur **flüchtig** an.
- Beim Scanning muss man den Text nicht genau verstehen, sondern nur die **benötigten Informationen** finden.

Man wendet die Lesetechnik **Scanning** an, wenn man:

1. ... **Fragen** hat, die man zu dem Text beantworten soll.
2. ... nach einer **bestimmten Information** sucht, wie zum Beispiel einer Jahreszahl.
3. ... nach **Namen** oder **Personen** sucht.
4. ... **bestimmte Begriffe** sucht.
