


# Teenage problems

## Nine-year-old girl finds both parents dead

Mr Adrian McCorkell, a paramedic, told the inquest that he was sent to a flat in Frankley, Worcester after the emergency services received a 999 call from a young girl. He arrived at 9.53 a.m. and the door was opened by a young girl who was in a "very distressed state". He entered the house and when he asked her to show him where her mother was, she pointed to a door at the end of the hall. Mr McCorkell said he found the body of Ms Van Hagen in the bedroom. "She had no pulse and it was obvious that she had been dead for some time." The young girl then took him to the living room where he found the lifeless body of Mr

Worton, the girl's stepfather. The body had been covered by a sheet. "The little girl was crying. I found her coat in the hall and put it around her shoulders. Just then a team of police officers arrived."

Dr Alexander Kolar, a police pathologist, told the court of inquest the results of his post mortem investigation. Both Ms Van Hagen and Mr Worton had taken lethal doses of paramethoxyamphetamine (PMA), also known as Dr Death or Pink Ecstasy. Mr Worton had also drunk "a considerable amount" of alcohol.

Coroner Louise Hunt declared a verdict of accidental death due to a drug overdose, principally PMA.

### 'Party' drugs

PMA, nicknamed 'Dr Death' for its lethal side-effects, has claimed the lives of 35 young people in the United Kingdom since January, 2014. The pills, which are available for as little as £3 each, are often pink and shaped like the sweets called 'Love Hearts' and they are stamped with an 'M'.

The amphetamine is also known as 'Pink Ecstasy', but it contains a different active ingredient which makes it as much as five times stronger.


PMA also takes longer to have an effect than Ecstasy, which means some users take more and accidentally give themselves fatal overdoses.

The youngest victim was 16-year-old Ellie Jones, who died after suffering breathing difficulties at a friend's house in Warrington.

PMA has also been linked to the deaths of eight revellers at a rave party in Canada and there have been other deaths in most European countries.
