I'd like a .../I'd like to ...

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We use **would like + noun** to say what we want to have. After a personal pronoun we often use the short form **'d like**.

Example: *I'd like a strawberry milkshake, please.*

We use **would like to + verb** to say what we want to do. Example: **I'd like to** lie down and rest for half an hour or so.

We use questions to offer something to somebody or to make suggestions (*Vorschläge machen*). Examples: *Would you like something to eat? Would you like to watch a video film?*

With *will* and *won't* we can react to situations and make decisions spontaneously (spontan).


