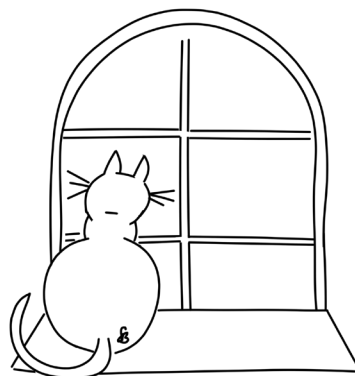

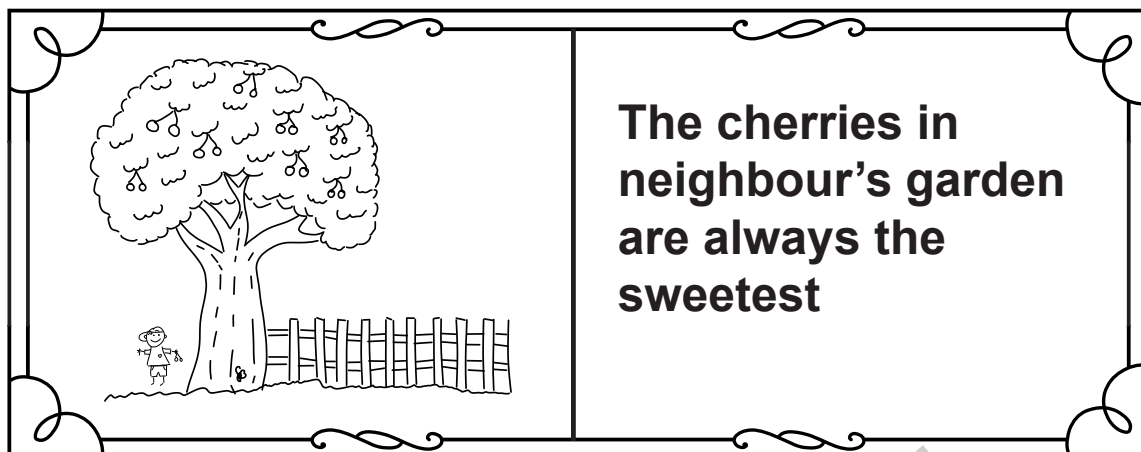

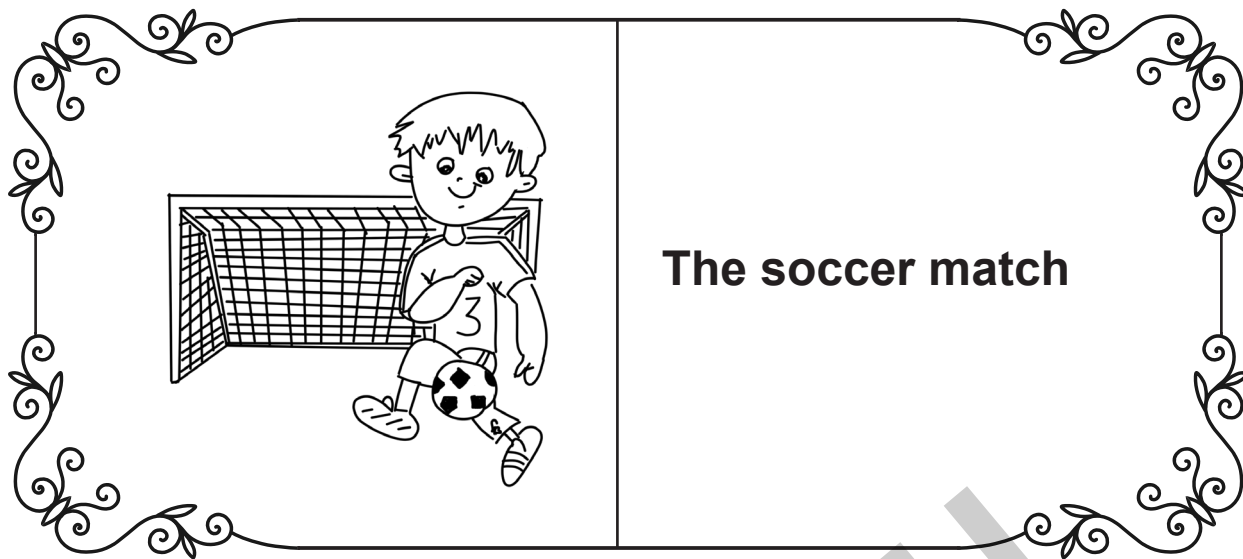


The cherries in neighbour's garden are always the sweetest

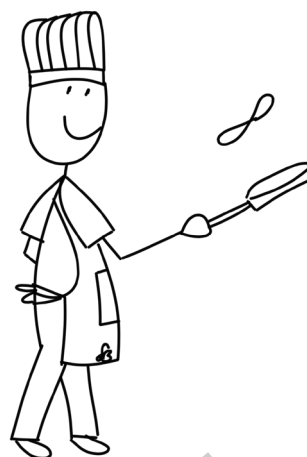












