some and any

- Die Begriffe *some* und *any* verwendest du, um eine unbestimmte Menge auszudrücken.
- Das Wort *some* verwendest du in bejahten Aussagen und höflichen Fragen.
- Das Wort *any* verwendest du in Fragen und verneinten Sätzen.
- Die Begriffe *some* und *any* kannst du mit „ein paar“, „etwas“ übersetzen.

Beispiele:

I'm looking for some books. (bejaht)

Would you like some biscuits? (Angebot) → *some*

Can I have some biscuits, please? (höfliche Frage)

I haven't got any books. (verneint) → *any*

Have you got any books? (Frage)

much and many

- Die Begriffe *much* und *many* verwendest du, um eine bestimmte Menge auszudrücken.
- Das Wort *many* verwendest du bei **zählbaren** Gegenständen/Personen im Plural („viele“).
- Das Wort *much* verwendest du bei **nicht zählbaren** Gegenständen („viel“).
- Das Wort *much* bedeutet „viel“ und *many* bedeutet „viele“.

How **many** apples do we have? – **Wie viele** Äpfel haben wir?

Not **many**. – Nicht **viele**.

How **much** money do we have? – **Wie viel** Geld haben wir?

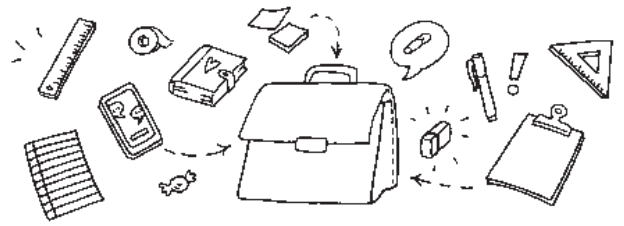
Not **much**. – Nicht **viel**.
