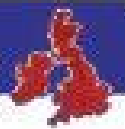




# BASIC ENGLISH IV.

He } lucky.  
She } was nice.  
it } it.

We } at the playground.  
You } were last.  
They } at the zoo.

### Long form

I was not  
You were not

He } was not  
She }  
it } it.

We }  
You } were not  
They }

### Short form

I wasn't at home.  
You weren't there.

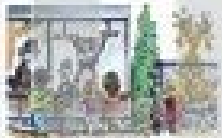
He } old.  
She } wasn't happy.  
it } far.

We } sad.  
You } weren't thirsty.  
They } with us.

Where were they? They were at the zoo.



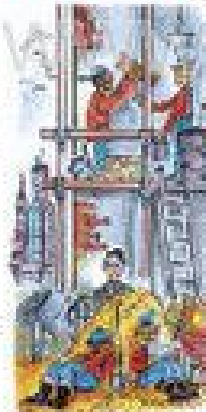
Was Lucy there too? No, she wasn't.

it }

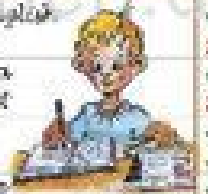

## PAST TENSE CONTINUOUS.

What were you doing? (at that moment, at that time)

I was }  
You were } sitting.  
He was }  
She was }  
It was }

I wasn't }  
You weren't } sitting.  
He wasn't }  
She wasn't }  
It wasn't }

at 7 p.m.? I was watching TV.
