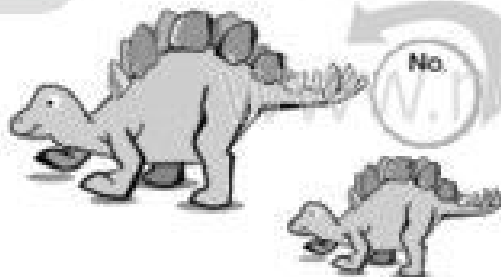


Mother and father Dinosaur watch out over the dinosaur egg.

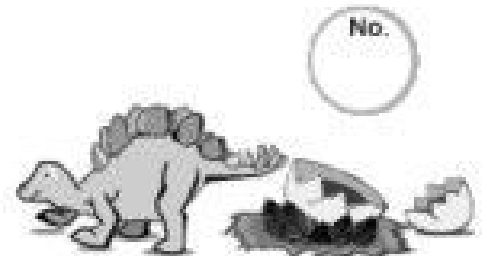

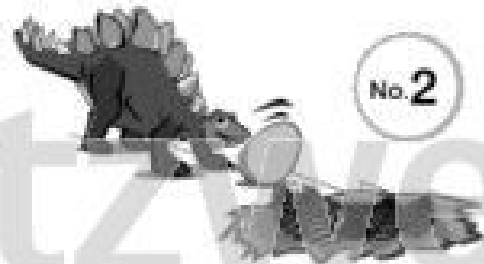

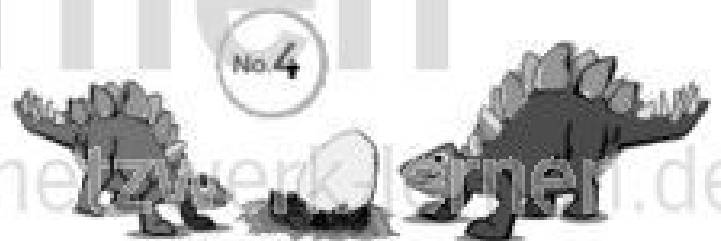

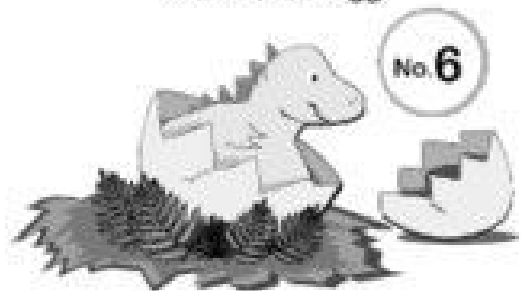

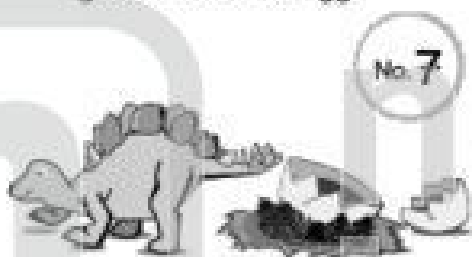

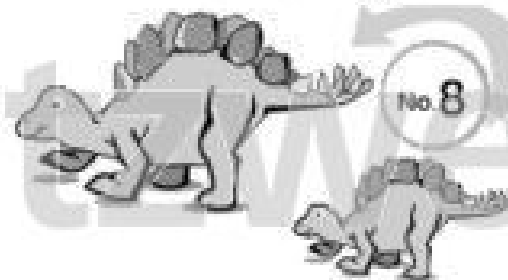
