(Gestern **gingen** wir **einkaufen**.)

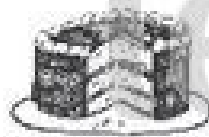


We **went shopping** yesterday.

(Bist du **jemals** auf einem Kamel geritten?)

Have you **ever** ridden on a camel?



Miriam has ... seen the sea.

(Miriam hat das Meer **nie** gesehen.)

Miriam has **never** seen the sea.

Nicola hasn't finished her picture ...

(Nicola hat ihr Bild **noch nicht** fertiggestellt.)

Nicola hasn't finished her picture **yet**.

Have you made your bed ...?

(Hast du dein Bett schon gemacht?)



Have you made your bed **yet**?

There are three churches here. We go to the ... in Chapel Street.

(Es gibt hier drei Kirchen. Wir besuchen die in der Chapel Street.)

There are three churches here. We go to the **one** in Chapel Street.

We've got lots of scarves - cotton ..., linen ... and silk ...

(Wir haben viele Schals - baumwollene, leinene und seidene.)

We've got lots of scarves - cotton **ones**, linen **ones** and silk **ones**.

Martha read the letter ...

(Martha las den Brief **langsam**.)



Martha read the letter **slowly**.

Ann can play ... for hours.

(Ann kann stundenlang **glücklich** spielen.)

Ann can play **happily** for hours.

Miss Taylor chose her words ...

Miss Taylor chose her words **carefully**.

Does Andrew play football ...?

(Spielt Andrew ...?)

Does Andrew play football **well**?

My parents work ...

(Meine Eltern arbeiten **hart**.)



My parents work **hard**.

Some people always behave ...

(Manche Menschen benehmen sich immer **schlecht**.)

Some people always behave **badly**.

In an emergency you must think ...

(In einem Notfall muss man **schnell** überlegen.)

In an emergency you must think **fast** (quickly).

Mr Tate had a bad accident and he now drives and

(Herr Tate hatte einen schlimmeren Unfall und jetzt fährt er **langsamer** und **vorsichtiger**.)

Mr Tate had a bad accident and he now drives **more slowly** and **more carefully**.

If the camping site is full, they ... * ... us ...

(Wenn der Campingplatz voll ist, **werden** sie uns **nicht reinlassen**.)

If the camping site is full, they **won't let** us **in**.

If this restaurant is too expensive, ... * ... somewhere else.

(Fallt dieses Restaurant zu teuer ist, **werden** wir irgendwo anders hingehen.)

* Kurzform!

If this restaurant is too expensive, **we'll go** somewhere else.

If you're in the neighbourhood, you us.

(Falls ihr in der Nachbarschaft seid, **müsst** ihr uns **besuchen**.)

If you're in the neighbourhood, you **must visit** us.

If you don't want to get wet, ... an umbrella.

(Wenn du nicht nass werden willst, **nimm** einen Regenschirm **mit**.)

If you don't want to get wet, **take** an umbrella.



If you buy eggs and potatoes, I a salad.

(Wenn du Eier und Kartoffeln kaufst, **kann** ich einen Salat **machen**.)

If you buy eggs and potatoes, I **can make** a salad.

If you can't see well, you ... * ... a cat.

(Wenn man nicht gut sehen kann, **sollte** man **nicht** Auto **fahren**.)

* Kurzform!

If you can't see well, you **shouldn't drive** a car.



The girl ... sat next to you has forgotten her bag.

(Das Mädchen, **das** neben dir saß, hat ihre Tasche **vergessen**.)

The girl **who (that)** sat next to you has forgotten her bag.



The dog ... bit Mr Grumble has died.

(Der Hund, **der** Herrn Grumble biss, ist gestorben.)

The dog **that (which)** bit Mr Grumble has died.

Is this the plane ... flew across the English Channel in 1909?

(Ist dies das Flugzeug, **das** im Jahre 1909 über den Ärmelkanal flog?)

Is this the plane **that (which)** flew across the English Channel in 1909?

Joanne Rowling is the woman ... invented Harry Potter.

(Joanne Rowling ist die Frau, **die** Harry Potter erfand.)

Joanne Rowling is the woman **who (that)** invented Harry Potter.

Is there anyone here ... parents work in the car factory?

(Gibt es hier jemanden, **dessen** Eltern in der Autofabrik arbeiten?)

Is there anyone here **whose** parents work in the car factory?

They're looking for somebody ... car is wrongly parked.

(Sie suchen **dessen** ...)

They're looking for somebody **whose** ...
