Carol ... in the fitness studio ... 1.30 pm.

(Carol ist schon **seit** 1.30 Uhr im Fitness Studio.)

Carol **has been** in the fitness studio **since** 1.30 pm.

Yesterday I ... my finger - but I ... go to hospital.

(Ich **schnitt** mich gestern in den Finger - aber ich **brauchte nicht** ins Krankenhaus zu gehen.)

Yesterday I **cut** my finger - but I **didn't need to** go to hospital.

... you ... or ... anything before you ... ?

(Hatten Sie irgendetwas **gegessen** oder **getrunken** bevor Sie sich übergeben?)

Had you eaten or **drunk** anything before you **were** sick?

Carol ... two and a half hours!

(Carol **trainiert** schon **seit** zweieinhalb Stunden!)

Carol **has been** **training** for two and a half hours!



Hindi ... in India.

(Hindi **wird** in Indien **gesprochen**.)

Hindi **is** spoken in India.



Newspapers ... at a newsagent's.

(Zeitungen **werden** bei einer Zeitschriftenhandlung **gekauft**.)

Newspapers **are** sold at a newsagent's.

Mr Wells ... a heart attack and ... to an emergency clinic.

(Herr Wells **hatte** einen Herzinfarkt und **wurde** zu einer Notfallklinik **gebracht**.)

Mr Wells **had** a heart attack and **was taken** to an emergency clinic.

Information for the project ... on the Internet.

(Informationen für das Projekt **können** im Internet **gefunden** werden.)

Information for the project **can be found** on the internet.

My grandparents' car ... never ... faster than 80 kilometres per hour.

(Das Auto meiner Großeltern **ist** nie schneller als 80 Kilometer in der Stunde **gefahren** worden.)

My grandparents' car **has never been driven** faster than 80 kilometres per hour.

Two hundred houses ... on this land.

(Zweihundert Häuser **werden** auf diesem Land **gebaut** werden.)

Two hundred houses **will be built** on this land.

(Plünderer **werden** ...)

Looters **will be shot!**
